- I. Introductions
  - a. Shannon Hampson introduced members of the 2009 GKAISA Board
    - i. **Motion** to accept change of treasurer from Susan Hughes to Tom Horne. **Motion** seconded. **Motion** passed. Susan will continue to assist

  - b. Tom Schuman is scheduling stroke and turn, referee and meet director clinics. For all clinics the training is moving away from using a swimmer to demonstrate the strokes and using instead USA Swimming videos to more accurately illustrate legal strokes.
